
Horizons Funding Makes a Difference Across the Nine Bay Area Counties



- With the help of Horizons, FACE TO FACE (SONOMA COUNTY) provides life-changing care services to 500+ clients living with HIV/AIDS and HIV prevention programs for hundreds more.
- Horizons' funding helps EL/LA PARA TRANSLATINAS (SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY) support TransLatinas in protecting themselves against violence, abuse, and illness, and in fully realizing their dreams.
 - RAINBOW COMMUNITY CENTER (CONTRA COSTA COUNTY) is the only queer-led organization in the county and focuses solely on serving the LGBTQ community. Horizons funding helps them build community by providing services for youth, seniors, and people living with HIV/AIDS.
 - PACIFIC CENTER FOR HUMAN GROWTH (ALAMEDA COUNTY) is one of the oldest LGBTQ community centers in the country and the only one serving all ages and families in the county. Funding from Horizons enables them to provide mental health services to over 3,500 people a year.
 - CHILD ADVOCATES OF SILICON VALLEY
 (SANTA CLARA COUNTY) recruits and
 trains Court Appointed Special Advocates
 (CASAs) to support LGBTQ foster youth. With
 support from Horizons, they've been able
 to recently launch an ambitious campaign
 to recruit 100 new volunteers to serve more
 LGBTQ young people.
